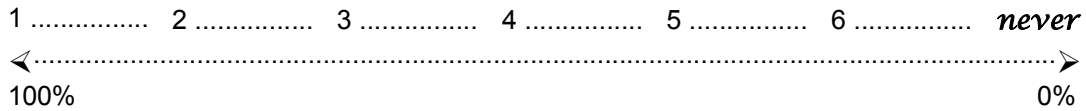




## Adverbs of Frequency Exercise
