check

verb

to look at something in order to make sure that it is right or correct.
Please check the door to make sure it is locked.

climb

verb

to move up or go towards the top.
*He climbed until he reached the top of the mountain.
The airplane climbed fast into the air.*

crack

verb

to break, but not into separate pieces.
The plate cracked, but it can still be used.

crash¹

verb

to destroy with great force and loud noise.
He crashed his new car into the wall.

dent¹

verb

to make a dent on or in.
I dropped the hammer and dented the table top.

happen

verb

to take place; occur.
*Two important events happened recently. My sister got married, and I changed jobs.
What happened? You're all wet.*

land

verb

to arrive on the ground or other surface.
The plane couldn't land because of the fog.

launch¹

verb

to put in motion with force.
He launched the paper airplane.

lift

verb

to move (something) upward; raise.
*The heavy suitcase was hard to lift off the floor.
The sick child lifted her head slowly.*

move

verb

to change position or place.
Let's move to better seats up front.

order

verb

to ask for something to be delivered or made.
*She ordered a dress from the catalogue.
Excuse me, but I ordered chicken, not beef.*

raise

verb

to move to a higher position.
